GIVING – SOME GUIDELINES

Gift Aiders. If you feel you want to increase your giving you can notify your bank or just increase the amount you put in your envelopes. You don't need to tell us you are doing this. The computer records will show the amounts so that the tax can be reclaimed if you have signed a gift aid form.

Non Gift Aiders. We are allowed to claim a gift-aid style repayment on a certain amount of donations that have not been gift aided. If you use envelopes but are not able to sign a gift aid declaration it is helpful if you use all your envelopes, rather than putting a month's giving into one. We cannot claim if there is more than £20 in one envelope or if there is a cheque.

Envelopes containing personal statements of donations made during 2018 by identifiable members of our congregation are available for collection in the church foyer. Donors who cannot be identified (who put loose cash in the collection bag) can take one of the un-addressed envelopes which are also available. These contain a 'thank you' letter and some other useful information about the church finances.
