**Children's Homes India Trust. Afternoon Tea** – October 14th 2017 1.30 – 4.30 pm. Tickets £4.00 Afternoon tea served from 2.30pm Guest speaker: Howard Mathers Chairman of CHIT (Charity reg no: 112048) CHIT was launched in 2005 in response to a cry for help from Mr Salagala Rajasekhara Babu who was maintaining 2 children homes and a school in Andhra Pradesh, South India and they help over 200 children each year. Babu had been running these homes since 1983 supported by Goodwill Children's Village Homes but that support was discontinued in 2004. All the children in the homes are from very poor families who are unable to cope and about 25% of them are "complete orphans" who without the help of CHIT would be left to fend for themselves on the streets. In many cases there is only one parent, often in ill health and struggling to bring up a family. Some of the children have lost parents to HIV/AIDS.
